AMPATUAN MUNICIPALITY







Kilantan Spring - kilantan derived its name from the word klan-taen, word means chaos, drought, dry season or no water Klan-taen is a sacred hunting ground of the Teduray tribe,

BULUAN MUNICIPALITY





Buluan Lake-It is located between the provinces of Sultan Kudarat and Maguindanao. Buluan Lake is the third largest lake in Mindanao after Lake Lanao and Lake Mainit. It has an estimated surface area of 61.34 square kilometres. A number of fish species, including climbing gurami, snakehead murrel, walking catfish, and spotted barb can be found in the lake. Among the best are the taruk and tilapia.





DATU ABDULLAH SANGKI MUNICIPALITY

Bual Spring – A tourist attraction identified in SItio Bisang, Barangay Talisawa, DAS. It is a natural spring locally called "Bual" which is maintained by the IP community surrounding the area. The Bual Spring has long been the source of potable drinking water of the residents of Sitio Bisang. This is also attracting nearby residents for its cold clear water often enjoyed by small groups over weekend. Thus, development and maintenance does not helf in preserving the nature, but would also call out tourist

Today, this is called "Seven Pools" an eco-tourism spot, providing development initiatives to beautify the attraction and accommodate tourist, but avoiding one —development which may destroy the natural charm of the place.





DATU ANGGAL MIDTIMBANG MUNICIPALITY

Mango Grove @ *the South* - is the newest nature spot in Datu Anggal Mindtimbang Municipality, Maguindanao del Sur. An idyllic retreat nestled among over 300 mango trees. Established in 2020. The resort is dedicated to providing the harmonious blend of modern comforts and natural beauty

Maliga Walay - Considered as the oldest house in Datu Piang, Maliga Walay or the Red House was built on 1936. It is the the house of Amay Mingka or Datu Piang, the first leader of the Place. Maliga Walay served as rendezvous for the meetings of the leaders on social issues of the place back then. Today, the historic Maliga Walay serves as the seat of government of the Municipality of Datu Piang.









DATU SAUDI MUNICIPALITY

Pink Mosque - Masjid Dimaukom also known as the "PINK MOSQUE" of Maguindano, it is situated at the heart of Datu Saudi Ampatuan town. Mayor Samsodin Dimaukom financed the construction of the mosque completed mid-2014. Its pink color was intended to symbolized peace and love, aside from being favorite color of his wife. Christian workmen were tasked to build this Islamic structure to emphasize unity and enter faith brotherhood









GENERAL SALIPADA K. PENDATUN

Ligwasan Marsh is a vast complex of river channels, extensive freshwater marsh, small freshwater lakes, ponds and arable land including old growth forest – also referred to as "wetlands" area.

A historical marker by the National Historical Commission was installed in the tomb honouring Gen. Salipada K. Pendatun and his many significant contributions to the country.










GUINDULUNGAN MUNICIPALITY

MAMASAPANO MUNICIPALITY

AL-RAHMAN FARMERS MPC FARM - One of the center for agricultural development is located at the heart of the Barangay Manungkaling which was established and founded by Dr. Modrika A. Masukat, Ph.D. of the Department of Agriculture-ARMM, now MAFAR-BARMM.

The organized farmers started the promotion of Organic Farming in 2013 by introducing the production of Organic Black, Brown and Red rice in a portion of a 4 hectares land out of the 7 hectares projected project.

The center for now is promoting the culture and production of MORE SAF 44, meaning Mamasapano Organic Rice Enterprise (MORE) 44 kinds or varieties of crops being planted to serve as Sustainable Agricultural Farming (SAF) with 44 sustainable food crops being produce.

For now, the AL-RAHMAN FARMERS MPC FARM is the major supplier of Organic Black, Brown and Red rice throughout the BARMM region. These innovation promotes livelihood and income among the farmers







Mamasapano Municipality



Miracle Mosque -The community believed it was existed during 14th Century, March 05, 1444. Once happened in 1951, there was the time a very huge and heavy "flash flood" over flown in this area, but only "MIMBAR' found inside the mosque was not flashed out. According to the three ustadzes namely Hadji Abdulmanan Matangkoy, Hadji Pawa Mulidis, and Hadji Akmad Manalasal, there had several amazing wonders happenings of this Mimbar.






PAGALUNGAN MUNICIPALITY

Old Nawasa Tank (National Water and Sanitation Association)



SHARIFF AGUAK MUNICIPALITY


The "Green Masjid" is located along national highway of Shariff Aguak, Maguindanao del Sur.
